Hillingdon Council's innovative and successful Street Champion Scheme is officially being launched in South Ruislip this September. The council will be recruiting volunteers from South Ruislip, Manor and Cavendish wards, as part of this locality area.

Street Champions are members of the public who act as the "eyes and ears" of Hillingdon. They report residents' concerns and environmental problems to the council in their local area ranging from graffiti, abandoned cars, noise, green space and pavement maintenance, litter and other anti social behaviour. Being a volunteer is easy to fit around your everyday life and you can do as little or as much as you like. The aim of the scheme is to enable local people to play a greater role in improving their neighbourhoods and making their area cleaner, greener and safer.

As a Street Champion you can provide a positive contribution to the community and help get issues sorted. There are six easy ways that you can contact the council to tell us your concerns and report problems, these are via the council website, by email, phone, fax, text message and through pre-paid check cards provided in your welcome pack you will receive if you sign up.

The launch is open to all residents and is taking place at Ruislip High school, Sidmouth Drive, HA4 0BY, on Thursday 18th September at 7.00 pm.
